Past President and Vice-Chancellor of The University of Hong Kong Winner, 2014 Henry G. Friesen International Prize in Health Research

Dr. Tsui has had a distinguished academic career with major discoveries in Genetics and Genomics. He identified the Cystic Fibrosis gene in the late 1980s and in further studies of the human genome, characterized chromosome 7. He contributed significantly to fighting the SARS coronavirus in 2003 and led the Hong Kong consortium in the international effort, completing the first comprehensive catalogue of the human genetic evaluations.
